LMSA, in its early days, is building out the team and is looking for a Digital Curation Intern. This is a paid internship for a duration of 6 months with the possibility of converting to a full-time position. The intern will oversee parts of the artist outreach, onboarding and community building efforts through research, presentations, communication, and relationship building initiatives with stakeholders. Curatorial duties also include researching, executing digital exhibitions, and writing about works in the collections; proposing and curating original exhibitions. The ideal candidate is expected to bring fresh and creative ideas, while helping build out the playbook for a digital art marketplace.

- Build and refine the collections through strategic acquisitions aligned with LMSA's Collections Development Plan
- Propose, develop, and implement exhibitions
- Oversee exhibitions involving collaborators or other outside stakeholders, as assigned
- Be responsive to changing organisational priorities
- Additional duties as requested

Requirements

- Some relevant work/ internship experience in primary or secondary art market, keen to channelise practical experience and learnings in the art ecosystem to build a digital art platform
- Undergrad or student of art history, art management, or similar
- Knowledge of e-commerce platforms and online art sales

- Collaborative approach and experience working on team-based projects
